# Highlights from the Tour

#### Gifu Auto Body - Aichi Prefecture

Experience the Toyota Production System in action with excellent examples of JIT delivery, electric kanban systems, poka-yoke, 5S and TPM in action at Gifu Body, a supplier of finished vehicles to the Toyota Group. The tour group will visit three separate factories at Gifu Body; the welding/paint/assembly factory, the pressed components factory, and the seat track factory for the Toyota Hi-Ace vehicle. Learn about the lean journey at Gifu Body, during two days of discussions led by a former manager. During this visit the group will also participate in practical training sessions on lean concepts in a world-class lean training facility.

#### JMA Consultants Lean Seminar - Tokyo
