

Highlights from the Tour

Toyota Motor Corporation - Gifu Prefecture

Take a behind-the-scenes tour of a Toyota production plant not open to the general public. The Gifu Auto Body honsha plant is responsible for the manufacture of the Toyota HiAce van and Toyota Coaster bus, and is consistently rated top within the Toyota Group for quality. The tour, led by a former factory manager and kaizen leader, focuses on the two pillars of the Toyota Production System; Jidoka and Just-In-Time.

Metal One Isuzu – Aichi Prefecture

Learn from a company that is the epitome of 5S implementation and standardisation. Isuzu specialises in the processing and sales of cold rolled steel, and understands that in order to remain profitable in an old economy industry, it must focus on cutting costs by boosting business efficiency. The company boasts an excellent corporate culture and an engaged, dedicated and vibrant workforce.

Rinnai - Aichi Prefecture

Visit a gas appliance and electronics company obsessed with quality. At Rinnai all employees participate in continuous improvement and Total Productive Maintenance efforts. Following the mantra 'quality is our destiny', Rinnai strives for a zero-defect status. Managers will lead a plant tour and presentation of Rinnai's business, with a focus on its multi-product, mixed-flow production system based on actual demand.

Toyota Body Seiko - Gifu Prefecture

Experience the Toyota Production System in action with excellent examples of JIT delivery, kanban, poka-yoke and 5S at Toyota Body Seiko, a first-tier supplier to the Toyota Group. The tour group will visit the welding and assembly operations, with the tour and discussion led by a former factory manager.

Suzuki Industries - Gifu Prefecture

Chairman Suzuki will lead us on a factory tour of this second-tier supplier to the automotive industry of pressed, welded and assembled components. The visit will focus on the implementation of kanban, excellent examples of poka-yoke, and demonstration of their efforts with SMED.

Lean Seminars and Toyota Production System Training Dojo

Reinforce your understanding of lean fundamentals through seminars delivered on the Japanese approach to lean. Topics include the Toyota Production System, standardized work, time studies, work sampling and leading and implementing a lean culture. The group will also participate in practical training sessions in a lean training dojo.

Japanese Cultural Experience

Enjoy a journey like no other as you immerse yourself in an exhilarating mix of cultural and sightseeing experiences. Take in Japanese food and culture and explore some of Japan's most amazing urban landscapes. The tour will commence with a seminar on Doing Business with the Japanese to provide participants with an understanding of Japanese culture and customs, business etiquette and insights into the management culture of Japanese companies.

Recommended International Flights



Participants are required to make their own air travel arrangements to and from Nagoya. This region of Japan is served by Chubu Centrair International Airport (NGO), 35km south of Nagoya. You will be met at the airport on arrival and a transfer to our hotel will be provided. Please time flights such that you arrive at the hotel in Nagoya by no later than 4pm on the starting Sunday of the tour.

Optional - Arrival in Tokyo

Participants may optionally choose to arrive at and depart from Narita International Airport (NRT) or Tokyo Haneda Airport (HND). For those requiring assistance in travelling between Tokyo and our hotel in Nagoya, meet service and bullet train transfers can be arranged. The cost of the train transfer between Tokyo and Nagoya is to be borne by the participant. Please allow around three hours for this transfer.
